He believed that both quality library staff and the FSDPL were integral parts of a successful San Diego Public Library System. The John McAllister Library Memorial Scholarship has an educational and a conference option. The educational scholarship may be applied towards registration fees, tuition, books, or other related school expenses. The conference scholarship may be applied towards the registration fees and transportation expenses for a library related conference. Full and part time employees working at the San Diego Public Library will be considered.

Educational Scholarship (up to \$1000, one award)	<p>Applicant must be enrolled in a Certificate or Degree curriculum in Library Science, Information Management, or related subject area.</p> <p>Applicant must have completed at least one course and include an unofficial copy of the most recent college transcript. The selected scholarship recipient will be required to submit an official transcript for verification of enrollment prior to disbursement.</p> <p>Additional requirements include a letter of recommendation, and a personal statement that includes your career goals and what assets you possess that make you a valuable employee of the library system.</p>
Conference Scholarship (up to \$500)	<p>Applicant must register to attend a library related conference where fees are not covered by the City or other scholarship/grant. Applicant must identify the track or elements of the program to be attended.</p> <p>Applicant must attach a copy of the conference registration form which lists the registration fee and provide an estimate for travel expenses. The selected scholarship recipient will be required to submit a copy of the paid receipts for registration and travel expenses prior to disbursement.</p> <p>Additional requirements include a letter of recommendation, and a personal statement that includes your career goals and what assets you possess that make you a valuable employee of the library system.</p> <p>If the award amount for a selected recipient is less than the maximum award amount, an additional recipient or recipients may be identified.</p>
